

Referee Assignor Got Soccer accounts

With FYSA using Got Soccer software for player and coach registration, it is also being utilized for referee registration with FYSA, and risk management. As FSR certifies referees for 2011, they are forwarding the info to FYSA, and referees are being notified via email with account info so they may log in and complete either a background check, or an age verification for youth players. FYSA requires that all referees assigned to FYSA games must be registered with FYSA and have an approved risk management status.

Assignors will have access to this data through an assignor account in Got Soccer. Assignors can use the Got Soccer assigning module if they desire, and information on that process will come out at a later time. **The initial phase is for assignors to have the ability to look up certified referees in Got Soccer and continue assigning as they have in the past. No assignor is required by FYSA to use Got Soccer to assign games.**

An assignors account has already been set up for you, your user name and password have been sent via email. If you need this information again, contact registrar@fysa.com.

To find out if a referee is certified by FSR for 2011 and has an approved Risk management status, select the yellow referee tab, then referees on the menu bar.

Select the Referee Search feature, then put in the referees name, spelled exactly as it is found on the FSR website, since exact spelling is necessary. You can also use the USSF license number. Click “apply filters”, and the name will appear. In order for a referee to be assigned to a FYSA game, the RM must be approved and the State Approved, must state he is approved.
