Bylaw changes will require a two-thirds (2/3) majority to pass, and rule changes will require a simple majority (50% + 1).

1. President (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Even Years
2. Vice President of Player/Coach Development (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Odd Years
3. Secretary (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Odd Years
4. Treasurer (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Even Years

Suggested Change:

3009. TERMS OF OFFICE

3009.1 OFFICERS	TERM	ELECTED
1. President (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Even Years
2. Vice President of Player/Coach Development (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Odd Years
3. Secretary (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Odd Years
4. Treasurer (Not serving more than four (4) consecutive terms)	Two (2) years	Even Years

Reasoning: Purpose to eliminate the term limit restrictions on the four (4) administrative officers. These officers are currently subject to review and affirmation by election every two years by the membership which should serve a check and balance as to their performance.

Rules Committee Comments and Procedures Required:

Submitted without comment to the membership subject to the satisfaction of the requirements under 4003.5.

This change was submitted after the sixty (60) day deadline for consideration at the AGM of 2006 and as required under the rules has been submitted to FYSA's Board of Directors for affirmation or rejection. Under FYSA Rule 4003.5 for consideration at the AGM will require a 2/3 affirmative vote FYSA's BOD at its meeting of July 28, 2006.

Controlling Rule(s):

4003.1. Submitting amendments to the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and/or Rules and Regulations shall be in writing to the Secretary of **FYSA**, by any Affiliate or its members. The document for which change is suggested shall be noted along with the article, section or sub-section and the proposed change. Proposed changes may be submitted anytime during the year **but no later than sixty (60) days prior to the AGM.** **(Emphasis added)**

4003.5. Filing late, after the sixty (60) day deadline, the proposal may then be referred to the Rules and Revision Committee for consideration at their next regularly scheduled meeting except if called up by the Board of Directors by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.

Lacking this affirmation by FYSA's BOD, the proposal will be considered filed out of order and not considered at this AGM.
