

## **USYSA Region III (EAST DIVISION) Premier League - Fall 2006**

US Youth Soccer Region III Premier League is starting its sixth year of the most competitive play possible considering the vastness of our region and the differing calendars of our member National State Associations. This is our mission. We will continue striving to find ways to make the league more competitive, thereby fulfilling the intent to provide regular, highly competitive games for our top teams. In addition, for the past three years participation in the league has given the opportunity to our teams to compete at the most prestigious youth championships in the country, The US Youth Soccer Region III Championship and The US Youth Soccer National Championship Tournament. With this in mind here are a few items that you need to note before applying and/or participating in the league.

The deadline for committing and applying to the US Youth Soccer Region III Premier League Fall 2006 program is July 7, 2006. The completed application must be accompanied by the Entry Fee Check of \$350 and another separate check of \$1,000 for the performance bond. Checks should be made out to US Youth Soccer Region III Premier League. Applications received after the deadline will be placed on a wait list.

The league is divided into three divisions; East – SC, NC, GA, and FL; West – OK, NTX, and STX; Central – LA, MS, TN, AL, and AR.

Teams are recommended for participation in the league by their National State Association Premier League Representative. Teams are selected for participation in the league by a committee made up of the representatives of the states participating in the Sub-Regional League. Teams recommended and selected should have been finalists or semi-finalists from their State Cup, top finishers in a recognized league, and have a proven record from top rated tournaments. The decision of the committee is final.

Teams that are chosen to participate will qualify for their state cup competition. Teams will have the opportunity to win a spot at the US Youth Soccer Region III Championship Tournament through RIII Premier League competition.

By nature of the participation of different states scheduling is naturally inflexible. In an attempt to help teams who wish to participate in the league, dates for play in the fall are chosen and announced as early as possible, generally as early as March. Also an attempt is made to omit weekends that have large regional and national tournaments. Every effort will be made to schedule game times so that a team will only have a one night hotel stay. Final times and location of games will be determined once the league knows the composition of all age groups.

The costs associated with playing in the league are a \$350 registration fee and a \$1,000 performance bond. Bonds may be cashed. Clubs with more than three teams participating in the league and in good standing may submit one bond. Teams are expected to pay referees prior to the start of each match (\$50 per team maximum). Teams will also bear the cost of hotels and travel. The state representative will assist with hotel contacts when necessary. Please take note that travel costs and time may be considerable due to the distances of our great region.

Clubs participating in the league are encouraged to host games. Please complete the field form and send back to Pearse Tormey – [tormey@aol.com](mailto:tormey@aol.com). The hosting organization should provide a site director, quality fields, and sufficient qualified officials through SYRA and local referee assignors.

## Play Dates for Fall 2006

The following dates will be used to schedule games for this coming season (U-15, 16, 17 and 18). **Teams must understand that there will be no black outs dates this year.** They need to be available to play on these dates. 9 games will require a maximum of 5 weekends from the list of dates. **Only State Cup games will take higher precedence over Region III Premier League games.**

Make up games or rain outs will need to be made up on or before November 18-19 (girls) and December 2-3 (boys) weekends. There will be no games scheduled after these dates.
