Dear Region D Affiliate:

Enclosed is the information you need to enter your teams in the Region D Cup. The Tournament is scheduled for March 25 & 26, 2006. It is not for recreational teams. It is for competitive teams. All age groups from U-9 to U-17 and U-19, boys and girls, are included. So bring your best teams.

The Region Cup winners in each age group are invited to represent the Region at the President's Cup (Note: U-9, U-10 & U-11 teams will not advance to President's Cup). That competition will be held in Region C (location to be determined), April 8 & 9, 2006. Any team entering the Region Cup must decide whether to commit to attending President's Cup. Yes, it is an added expense, however the Region pays the entry fee and it is also a chance at a state championship and the possibility of a **Region III Championship**.

Each team entry must include the entry fee (**check payable to FYSA Region D Vice President**), a roster form, and a completed entry form (which includes the club's agent of record signing the form). The package must be in the **District Commissioner's hands by December 15, 2005**. The roster may be changed up to the roster freeze date. For competition purposes the official roster will be the one provided by the State Office.

All players, coaches and spectators will be expected to adhere to the Code of Conduct, which is attached. All players must have the same team code. No team may have players who are on team(s) involved in State Cup. The team can not be involved in State Cup. The roster included with the Region Cup entry form does not register, transfer, or drop players. All the player registrations, transfers, etc must be done separately on the appropriate paperwork and submitted through your District Commissioner. The paperwork must be in the **FYSA State office by February 7, 2006**.

Make sure the coaches of the entering teams get the entire package, including the Rules and Regulations. If you need more entry packets, contact your District Commissioner. Hopefully, they will be overwhelmed with your requests.
