

FYSA Pre-Season Birth Verification

Between June 1st and July 15th, affiliates may birth verify new players and currently unverified players at no charge. This should assist those affiliates participating in early league games. After July 15th when these players are registered for the 2008-2009 season, there will be no delay in obtaining a verified US Youth Soccer player pass.

For players currently in the FYSA database, birth documentation will be processed at no charge. All birth documentation should be sent to the FYSA office, with the pass number clearly printed on the documents. The preferred method for sending the information is scanned documents sent in a .pdf file to bc@fysa.com. That gives FYSA an email address that can be easily used if more information is needed. Faxes are often illegible and are not recommended.

For players that have not registered with FYSA and do not have a pass number registrars can send a player upload file to briggs@fysa.com and attach scanned birth documents in a .pdf file. The players will be assigned a pass number and verified. When it is time to register the players for league or tournament play, the players can be uploaded with the correct pass number, available via player look up. When processed, the player will be listed on the roster as verified and a verified US Youth Soccer pass will be available for competitive players.

This pre-season verification will be done following all the other parameters regarding birth verification including, but not limited to, requirements for international clearance and proper birth documentation.

On July 15th, when players and coaches can be registered, this free service will no longer be available and birth documentation must be supplied within ten (10) days of upload to avoid late fees.
