

Team Coding

District Club Team Code League

The first 2 characters (District) in the team code identify the Region and District, such as A1, B2, C3, D4 etc.

The next 3 characters (Club Code) identify the affiliate, and are the official codes given to the affiliate by FYSA.

The middle three characters, (Team Code) identify the age, and level of competition. Of those 3, the first identifies the age group. FYSA'S registration process limits players to those UNDER the specified age as of Aug 1 of the current year.

The second character identifies the gender and competition level.

0 signifies a competitive boys or co-ed team
1 signifies a competitive female team
4,5 and 6 signifies a recreational boys or co-ed team
7-8-and 9 signifies a recreational female team

The third character identifies the specific team within the club.

The last 3 characters of the team code, identify the league in which the team will participate. If the team is participating in an in-house program, then the club code should be used as the team code. Inter Club leagues can pull the rosters of all teams that use their league code as the last three characters.

Nothing in the team code identifies the league division, or cup level of a specific team. Nothing in the team code identifies if a team is active in State or Region Cup since it is application to those Cups by any team in good standing that makes them State or Region Cup teams, not the team code.

Recreational coded teams may participate in in-house leagues, recreational inter-club leagues, Americas' Cup, DC Cup, and any other competition that accepts recreational teams.

Competitive coded teams may participate in Competitive Inter-Club leagues, State and Region Cup, President's Cup, Competitive tournaments, and any other competition that accepts competitive teams.

Some examples are

A1 XXX 701 SFU – a U 17 boys comp team in A1 that plays in the SFU league.

B2 XXX 244 XXX – A U 12 boys team that plays in house in B2

C4 XXX 511 CDL a U 15 girl's team in C4 that plays in the USA league

A2 XXX 411 UGS a U 14 girls team playing in FLUGSA

B3 XXX 509 GCF a U 15 boys team, playing in the GCF league

C2 XXX 671 GYS a U 16 girls recreational team playing in GYSA (recreational league)

D2 XXX B46 XXX A U 8 in house team.
