

FSPL/ Sunshine Conference Updates

Our current situation continues to evolve every day but if we work together and maintain our discipline individually, as a team, as a club, and as a community, we will get back to full unrestricted play sooner rather than later. While some organizations and clubs in Florida may be ready to return to play and competition, there are many clubs that are not in the same situation. Exposure to participants to potential risk of infection for the benefit of our sport is not acceptable. FYSA asks that each coach, team official, and parent commit the discipline it will take to get past this by committing to protocols put in place for return to play. While we have set game day protocols until there is tangible interventions, including vaccines, widespread testing, or other factors making play ethical and safe, we recognize that some members in areas harder hit may choose to implement more restrictive protocols and policies. The priority of adherence to policies and procedures should be as follows:

- Municipality proclamation
- Parks and Recreation Field Authority
- FYSA Game Day Protocols

Game Change Protocols:

- ✓ Home and away designations to not constitute where matches shall be played.
- ✓ Movement of matches will need both team's approval prior to submitting an actual reschedule request.
- ✓ Please do not include your communication regarding changing the match once details are finalized please use the following guidelines to move the match:

Changes to schedule must be completed by August 31, 2020
