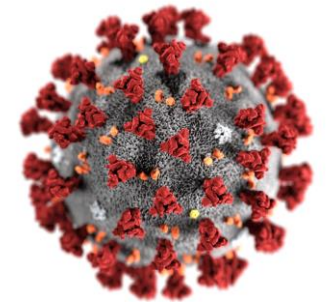
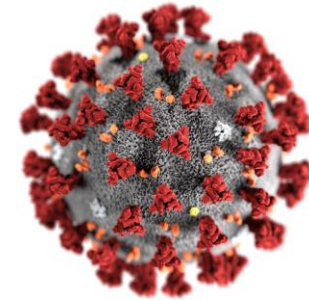
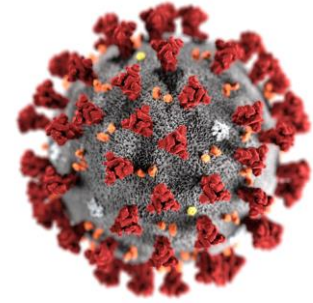
Timeline

FYSA:

- March 12- FYSA suspension of state level play. Recommended affiliate suspension of (April 12).
- March 18- Mandatory suspension of all play (April 15).
- March 20- USYS updates/FYSA Competitions
- April 1- Extension of FYSA Suspension (May 3). Regional/National competitions canceled.

USYS:

- March 10- Cancellation of Las Vegas Showcase
- March 13- Travel advisory
- March 13- April 15 recommended return to play
- March 23- ODP East and South Championships canceled
- March 31- Cancellation Regional/National competitions. May 1 return to play recommendation.

Player Registration Fees

FYSA

- Player insurance valid until August 1
- FYSA has not been refunded for registration fees from USYS (\$2.25) or US Soccer (\$1.00)
- FYSA insurance premiums based on 100,000 participants (no prorated or adjusted payments yet)
- \$6.85 per registrant for PA/GL/Excess coverage
- Practices & Games
- FYSA Bucks- \$87,000+

Membership

- Expecting no additional player registrations (return to play dependent)
- Recommended suspension of play March 12
- Member financial hardships
 - Case by case
 - Supporting documentation will be requested
- March billing delayed until Monday, April 13

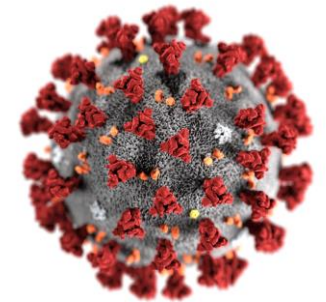
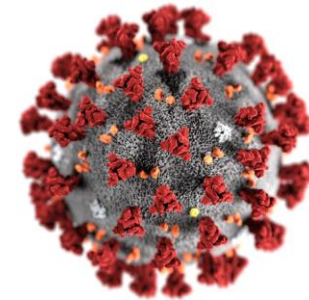
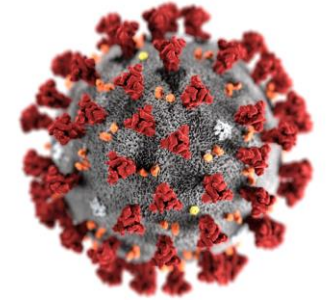


FYSA Competitions

401.6 TRY-OUTS

*Organizations affiliated with FYSA may hold any try-out or player identification activity, related to the formation of teams for the next seasonal year involving players **IN ALL AGE GROUPS** on the Monday following the **originally scheduled date of the FYSA State Cup Round of 16** provided the following guidelines are met:*

Tryouts or other activities are publicly advertised and open to all age-appropriate players. Players remain bound to their existing club for the current seasonal year pursuant to provisions contained in Rule 207.6.

Violations may result in the Club's affiliation with FYSA being reviewed, and it may be denied by the BOD.

FYSA tryouts are currently scheduled for May 18

SBA – Disaster Loan Program

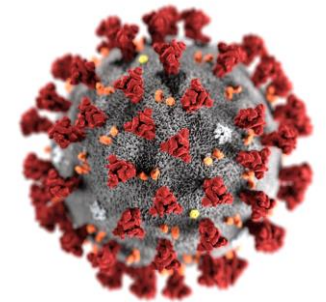
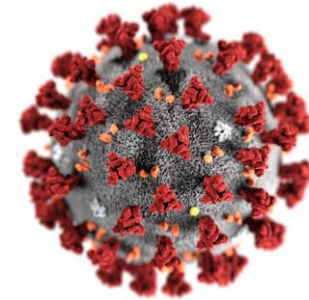
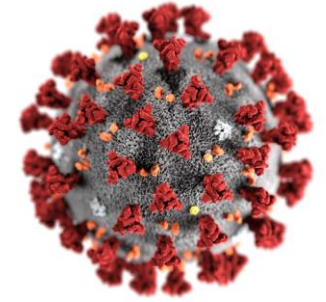
Our nation's small businesses are facing an unprecedented economic disruption due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. On Friday, March 27, 2020, the President signed into law the CARES Act, which contains \$376 billion in relief for American workers and small businesses.

The SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loan program provides small businesses with working capital loans of up to \$2 million that can provide vital economic support to small businesses to help overcome the temporary loss of revenue they are experiencing.
