SUNSHINE CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

- Club v Club and Team v Team Divisions
 - 188 teams registered across the Team and Club divisions
- Champions in each age group advance to USYS Southern Regionals
 - Teams who qualify via the Sunshine Conference, must play State Cup in order to be eligible
- National League Conference Playoffs:
 - Top 2 teams from UI3-UI6 age groups and the winner from the UI7 age group qualify for the National league Conference Playoffs the following season
- Teams who finish in last place are relegated to FSPL the following year.
- Matches Played Per Season:
 - 13-17U age groups: 12-18 matches
 - 18-19U age groups: 7-9 matches (Fall Only)

Structure: 10 Groups of 4 in Playoffs, Knockout in NL P.R.O. (minimum of 3 games per event) Team Goals: Qualify for NL P.R.O., Win NL P.R.O., Qualify for National Championships





CONFERENCE PLAYOFFS - ADVANCEMENT

- Conference Playoffs feature 40 teams per gender/age group (14U thru 18/19U), divided into 10 groups of 4.
- Teams qualify for the Conference Playoffs through their performance in the Conference the previous year.
- 30 teams (75%) advance to NL P.R.O., with their finish at Conference Playoffs determining pool placement at NL P.R.O.

SELF-SCHEDULING

- Teams are responsible for inputting kickoff times and venue info for Home Games only.
- Teams are responsible for assigning referees for self-schedule Home games
- The deadline to input this information in GotSport is <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 8th</u>.
- Attempt to schedule back-to-back games (retain referees) and have a site director present

RESCHEDULING

- All neutral venue reschedules will result in a \$250 fee subject to FYSA's approval.
- Self-schedule reschedule requests within 7 days of the original date are subject to a \$250 fee.
- Reschedule requests outside of emergencies, weather and other catastrophic circumstances must be agreed upon by both teams. Both teams must agree upon a reschedule within the GotSport Chat before submitting a reschedule form.
- Should a game be cancelled due to inclement weather, teams will have 10 days to reschedule the match to a new date. If a new date is not determined by then, FYSA will choose a new date for the game.
- All reschedules must be submitted via 2023-24 FYSA Reschedule Request Form in GotSport (see below). This link can be found on the FSPL page on the FYSA website and the Public Schedule.
- FYSA will have final approval on all reschedule requests.

PRE-GAME RESPONSIBILITIES

- Home & Away Team Responsibilities:
 - Provide a Sunshine Conference Game Report to the referees at least 30 minutes prior to kickoff
 - Present the Player/Coach laminated passes for the active players listed on the Game Report
 - Provide at least one match ball to the referees
 - Provide officials with the referee fees (cash on the field):

POST-GAME RESPONSIBILITIES

- Home Team Responsibilities:
 - Use the GotSport Match Stats to:
 - Input final-score
 - Upload game report
 - Input Red Cards

 - Supplemental Reports & Serving Suspensions:
 - The home team must ensure the referee assignor submits any supplemental reports to FYSA via the Game/Supplemental Report GotSport Form:
 - Teams must also submit game reports where players serve suspensions via the same form.

ROSTERING

- Max Roster Size: 22 players
- Gameday Roster: 18 players
- Primary and Club Pass (CP) players only (no Secondary/Guest Players)
- A player cannot be simultaneously rostered to more than one team in the same gender age group division in Sunshine Conference
- Players are allowed to Club Pass to other teams within the same club in FSPL if none of those teams are in the same gender age group
- All rosters will be built in the 2023-2024 FYSA Registration Event (Roster Source)

SUBSTITUTION RULE

- UI3 UI4 Age Groups: Unlimited Substitutions
- UI5 UI9 Age Groups will operate under the FIFA 7 players "Per Half" substitution system. Once replaced, players cannot re-enter the game during that half of play.
- It is the responsibility of the teams to understand and follow the substitution rule.

PLAYER UNIFORMS

- The referee is the sole judge of allowed player equipment as prescribed by FIFA Laws of the Game.
- Home Team should wear Light colors (Jerseys and Socks)
- Away team should wear Dark colors (Jerseys and Socks)
- In the event of a uniform color conflict, the team causing the conflict will need to change jerseys and socks.

FYSA CUP COMPETITIONS

- Registration for State Cup & Presidents Cup are now open (Sunshine Conference teams are not eligible to play Presidents Cup)

SPECTATOR/TEAM BEHAVIOR

- It will be the responsibility of the coaches to control the behavior of their parents/players.
- Teams who receive ejections due to abusive language, inappropriate spectator behavior or physical violence are subject to fines and removal from the competition.
