Tournament Game Reports/Supplemental Reports

Please be aware that per FYSA Rule 901, the following forms are required to be used by the tournaments sanctioned by FYSA. Modifications to the game report and supplemental report as the addition of tournament logos and sponsors is acceptable. Context of forms cannot be changed.

- a. Official FYSA or USSF Game Report
- b. Official FYSA or USSF Supplemental Report
- c. Official USSF Game Report and Supplemental Report to be used for referee abuse and assault

Failure to use the forms listed in A, B and C above will result in a fine to the tournament of \$100 per incorrect form used. This change is effective as of January 1, 2010.

This means that if you are using an outside software provider to run your tournament (e.g., Got Soccer, Demosphere, etc), you may use their game "reports" as game cards or rosters of players cleared at credentials but you must still use the official reports listed above as the official game reports. You must ensure that if you do use those game cards, you have verified the information against official documents (roster and guest player forms) before sending them out to games and they should accompany an official game report. It is on the official FYSA or USSF game report that any and all cards must be noted (including games served) and a supplemental must be attached for ALL red cards.
