# **Roster Procedures and Requirements**

### Roster Requirements:

- Maximum Roster Size: 22
- Minimum Roster Size: 11
- Only Primary and CP (Club Pass) players allowed
- At least 9 Primary Players
- Up to 13 CP Players Allowed
- No guest/secondary players allowed Players that are registered with a different club
- Players can only be on 1 roster in Presidents Cup (cannot appear on 2 different rosters)
- Players cannot be simultaneously rostered in a Commissioner's Cup/Presidents Cup/State Cup team still active in the competition
- Presidents Cup Roster Freeze:
  - <u>February 14, 2024, at 5pm</u>

# Uniforms

- Teams will be required to communicate uniform colors with each opponent within the GotSport Chat no later than 48 hours before each match.
- Home Team Wears Light Colors (Jersey and Socks)
- Away Team Wears Dark Colors (Jersey and Socks)
- In the event of a color conflict, the team causing the conflict will need to change (Both teams should always bring both Jerseys and Socks sets)



## Team Responsibilities – Pre-Game Procedures

### • Team Check-In:

- On March 2-3, a representative from each team will check-in at HQ before your first game to collect player gifts
- Teams will check-in at the fields with the referees before every game
- Make sure to arrive at least 1 hour prior to your game at your field
- Each team will pay half of the referee fee in cash before the game (Please see the referee fee on the next column).
- Each team will need to bring the following items:
  - At least one size 5 game ball
  - Player/Coach Passes (laminated and cut)
  - Game Report (self-schedule match only)

### Referee Game Day Instructions (Self-Schedule Match)

#### **Pre-Game Information and Procedures:**

- Game Reports:
  - Teams will provide the Game Report (referee chooses one copy as the official).
  - No players can be written in on the game report at all. Must use what is on the game report as that is the frozen roster.
  - Each team must declare their game day active 18 cross out the players who are not part of that or not in attendance.
  - All player/coach passes must be verified by the referee. If there is no pass, there is no play!
  - Check each player's jersey number and adjust it on the game report if needed.
- Substitutions:
  - For all age groups, unlimited substitutions shall be allowed.
  - Substitute may not enter the field of play until the player he/she is replacing has left the field, and after being signaled onto the field by the referee. Substitutions will be allowed at any stoppage by either team, with the referee's permission.

#### Post-Game Procedure:

- Game Report must have all red/yellow cards entered in and include any supplemental reports for red cards. If there are any red cards, submit Game Report and Supplemental Report through the Game/Supplemental Report form: <u>https://system.gotsport.com/forms/140218Z64</u>
- Both teams sign the Game Report; all 3 referees must print their names on the Game Report.
- Allow both teams to take a picture of the Game Report, then give it to the Home Team.

## Team Responsibilities – Post-Game Procedures

• Once the game is completed, both teams need to sign the Game Report and take a picture of it.

#### For Self-Schedule games:

- The team listed as the HOME TEAM is responsible for:
  - Entering the final-score on GotSport
  - Enter any Red Cards
  - Taking a picture of the Game Report and upload it on GotSport (make sure final score and referees' names are included)
  - If the final-score and/or Game Report is not uploaded within 2 business days, the Home Team will be charged a fine of \$50.00.

#### For FYSA Neutral Venue Weekend Games (March 2-3):

> FYSA will collect all Game Reports and update scores and red cards

At the conclusion of the match, please make sure that the bench area is cleaned and that all trash is disposed of in a proper manner.

## **Technical Staff & Spectator Behavior**

- Technical Staff who cause issues will be carded/Ejected from matches
- Match officials will provide warnings and that is it; FYSA staff will not intervene or provide warnings
- Spectators
  - $\circ$  Spector disruption will result in fines for the club
  - FYSA staff will contact a team's manager to warn/control their spectators or sideline
  - If disruption continues, security will remove any individuals deemed to be continuous causing disruption
  - FYSA staff will not intervene in any spectator disputes; Complaints about referee decisions or judgement calls will not be entertained
  - No parents or spectators should enter the field or player sidelines at any point in time
