



2025-26 FSPL – Game Day Instructions for Referees

Pre-Game Information and Procedures:

Game Reports:

- o Teams will provide the Game Report (referee chooses one copy as the official).
- No players can be written in on the game card at all without FYSA's approval. Must use what is on the game card.
- Each team must declare their game day active 18-player roster. Cross out the players who are not part of that or not in attendance.
- All player/coach passes must be verified by the referee. If there is no pass, there is no play!
- Check each player's jersey number and adjust it on the game card if needed.

• Substitutions:

- o For all age groups, unlimited substitutions shall be allowed.
- Substitute may not enter the field of play until the player he/she is replacing has left the field, and after being signaled onto the field by the referee. Substitutions will be allowed at any stoppage by either team, with the referee's permission.

Post-Game Procedure:

- Game Report must have all red/yellow cards entered in and include any supplemental reports
 for red cards. If there are any red cards, turn in Game Report and Supplemental Report to HQ or
 submit them through the Game/Supplemental Report form:

- Both teams sign the Game Report; all 3 referees must print their names on the Game Report.
- Allow both teams to take a picture of the Game Card, then give it to the Home Team.
