



2025-26 State Cup - Gameday Instructions for Referees (at FYSA Venue)

Pre-Game Information and Procedures:

Game Reports:

- All game reports will be provided by FYSA, which will be inside the box/container designated to the field or handed by a field marshal. Do not use game reports provided by the teams.
- No players can be written in on the game report at all. Must use what is on the game report as that is the frozen roster.
- Each team must declare their game day active 18 cross out the players who are not part of that or not in attendance.
- All player/coach passes must be verified by the referee. If there is no pass, there is no play!
- o Check each player's jersey number and adjust it on the game report if needed.

Substitutions:

Age Group	Substitution Procedure	
13U - 14U	Unlimited over three (3) moments per half + halftime	
15U - 19U	Unlimited over four (4) moments per match + halftime	

- o Player re-entry is allowed during one of the team's allotted moments.
- Overtime: teams may make substitutions between end of regulation and before the start of overtime and will
 also be granted two additional substitution moments during overtime play.
- Temporary Sub (Concussion Subs):
 - if a player is suspected of suffering a head injury by the referee, such player may be substituted for evaluation. The substitution for the evaluation of a concussion/head injury will not count toward the teams' total allowable moments and player must replace original substitute.
 - If the temporary substitute receives a red card, the team will play with a player down and the player suspected of suffering a head injury may return replacing another player on the field, which will not count as a used substitution moment.

Post-Game Procedure:

- Game Reports must have all red/yellow cards entered in and include any supplemental reports for red cards.
- Both teams sign the Game Report & all 3 referees must print their names on the Game Report.
- Leave the Game Report and Supplemental Report (if applicable) inside the container/box (that is designated to your field) inside the plastic Ziploc. A field marshal will come to collect the Game Report from each container/box.
